LumaLux Shelf Installation Instructions

Each LumaLux shelf includes heavy-duty arc-style brackets designed for safe, long-term support. While slightly more involved than traditional floating shelf hardware, these brackets offer stronger, more stable installation - ideal for laminated MDF and open-back shelf designs.

What's Included:

- Arc-style powder-coated steel brackets
- Screws and anchors (may vary by kit)
- Optional L-brackets for added stabilization (select sizes)

Tools You'll Need:

Tools You'll Need:

- Power drill
- Screwdriver
- Level
- Stud finder or heavy-duty drywall anchors
- Countersink bit (recommended for anchor screws)
- (Optional) construction adhesive



Installation Steps:

- I. Position the Brackets: Lay your shelf face down. Place the arc-style brackets so the horizontal arms fit just beneath the top panel inside the open back of the shelf.
- 2. Optional: Carve Recesses: For a flush fit, you may route or chisel shallow grooves where the bracket arms will sit.

 This is optional, but improves stability and appearance.

- 3. Drill & Secure the Shelf: From the top panel, carefully predrill small holes down into the bracket arms. Use short screws (3/4" max) to anchor the shelf to the brackets. Use a countersink bit to ensure screw heads sit flush with the surface.
- 4. Mount to the Wall: Use a stud finder to locate wall studs and anchor the vertical bracket arms directly into them. If studs aren't available, use high-quality wall anchors rated for your shelf load.
- 5. Level and Tighten: Use a level to ensure your shelf is perfectly straight, then fully tighten all hardware.
- 6. (Optional) Add Adhesive or L-Brackets: For high-traffic areas or heavier shelf use, add a line of construction adhesive inside the shelf frame or use included L-brackets for extra stabilization.

Safety First:

We recommend installing one bracket every 10-12 inches of shelf length. Always anchor into studs when possible. If you're unsure about your wall type or installation method, consult a qualified contractor.
